Treatment of a Pressure Ulcer using TransCu O₂[®]

Patient:	50 year old Caucasian female with a pressure ulcer that has progressively gotten larger, deeper, more malodorous, fibrotic, and necrotic
Comorbidities:	Diabetes, diabetic retinopathy & peripheral neuropathy
Age of Wound:	90 days
Days on Service:	55 days
Outcome:	Goals met. Wound healed. High patient satisfaction.
Previous Therapies	Multiple debridements, local wound care with various wound care products, and an attempt at primary closure
